**The Health and Safety at Work (Dangerous Substances)  
(Guernsey) Regulations, 1987**

*Made* *17<sup>th</sup> December 1987*

*Coming into operation* *1<sup>st</sup> January 1987*

**THE STATES LABOUR AND WELFARE COMMITTEE**, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 36 (1)(e) of the Health and Safety at Work (General) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1987, and in exercise of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes following Regulations:

**Dangerous substances**

1. For the purpose of paragraphs 13(2)(a) and 14(2) of Part I of Schedule 2 to the Health and Safety at Work (General) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1987, the substances specified in the Schedule to these Regulations are hereby deemed to be “dangerous substances”.

**Interpretation**

2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948 applies to the interpretation of these Regulations as if they were an enactment.

**Citation**

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Health and Safety at Work (Dangerous Substances) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1987.

**Commencement**

4. These Regulations shall come into operation on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January, 1988.

SCHEDULE

Regulation 1

DANGEROUS SUBSTANCES

The substances set out in –

- (a) Part I A, B, C, and Parts IV and V of the “Information approved for the classification, packaging and labelling of dangerous substances for supply and conveyance by road” (The Approved List), publication of which was approved by the Health and Safety Commission on 15 May, 1984, as amended by the “Revision No.1 to the Approved List”, publication of which was approved by the Commission on 5<sup>th</sup> August, 1986;
- (b) Parts I A2, IB and IC of the said Revision No.1.
